

- Visual and physical links to Sydney Harbour
- Green shorelines and living sea walls

PRIORITY: IMMEDIATE 2015 - 2019




- Hub for knowledge intensive and advanced technological industries

- Commencing 2016

PRIORITY: MEDIUM-TERM 2019 - 2022




- Integrating living and working with maritime uses

- Employing planning processes that will consider future uses of this Destination






