





An interactive alternative to Powerpoint. Allows students to collaborate on one presentation together. Students can incorporate images and videos very easily. Example of an assessment task - http://bit. ly/1RJpxVq



Sway

An online alternative presentation tool for Office users. Easy to use, interactive format and easily shareable. Create revision sheets for students, student projects and collaborative tasks. Examples -



- 2. In the classroom at my school all students have a school Twitter account linked to their school email and we have completed the following activities with them Year 10 http://bit.ly/1Y09OGi





Education Perfect - Social Science




