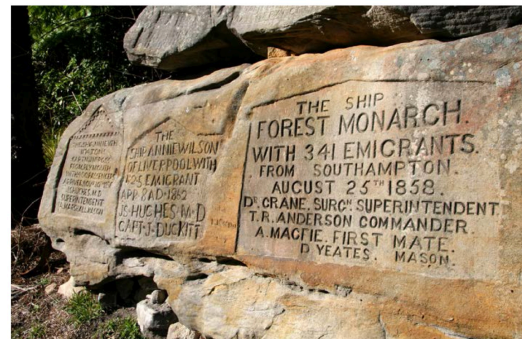


Lesson 5 – Resource Sheet 1







Little Penguin Critical Habitat

Highest population of Little Penguin population under List 1 of the Threatened Species Conservation Act 1995.

Critical Habitat Area A
Area A (red) includes the strip along the northern side of Canning River and the Canning River and Canning Drain. It includes the riparian zone and extends to the water's edge. It is bounded by the Canning River to the north, the Canning River to the south, the Canning River to the east and the Canning River to the west.

Critical Habitat Area B
Area B (yellow) includes the strip along the southern side of Canning River and the Canning River and Canning Drain. It includes the riparian zone and extends to the water's edge. It is bounded by the Canning River to the north, the Canning River to the south, the Canning River to the east and the Canning River to the west.

Potential Penguin Habitat
Area C (green) includes the strip along the southern side of Canning River and the Canning River and Canning Drain. It includes the riparian zone and extends to the water's edge. It is bounded by the Canning River to the north, the Canning River to the south, the Canning River to the east and the Canning River to the west.

Area A and Area B are subject to the same rules as Critical Habitat Area A.

Waterways

Minimal Impact Code

- Only enter buildings escorted by a guide
- Respect guests privacy and refrain from looking through windows
- Smoke only in designated areas
- Do not enter bush land
- Do not feed wildlife
- Dispose of all litter in bins provided
- No flash photography near grassy areas or bush land
- Be quiet whilst on or around a tour group
